9 In response to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (the “CARES  
10 Act”) and pursuant to *Amended General Order 37* (issued May 18, 2020), the Court adopted  
11 *Amended Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1020* and related amended Official Forms 101, 122A-1,  
12 122B-1, 122C-1, and 201. On March 27, 2022, provisions of the CARES Act necessitating the  
13 adoption of *Amended Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1020* and the related amended Official Forms  
14 expired.

15 **NOW THEREFORE**, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2071, Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of  
16 Civil Procedure, and Rule 9029 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the court  
17 **ORDERS** as follows:

- 18 1) *Amended General Order 37* is hereby abrogated;  
19 2) *Amended Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1020* is hereby rescinded, and the related  
20 amended Official Forms 101, 122A-1, 122B-1, 122C-1, and 201 shall no longer  
21 be used in this Court; and  
22 3) [General Order 37](#) shall remain effective.
